



Put motorcycle on stand.

Remove the cover's bolt of shock head, by Flat-blade screwdriver. Then remove shock OEM, by loosening 2 bolts of shock with 17 mm socket wrench and 8 mm hexagon.



Install the Öhlins shock absorber with the rebound adjuster towards the front. The thin ball joint spacers shall be on the right side of the vehicle, so that the shock absorber centre is as far to the right as possible. See figure. Raise the rear wheel slightly so that the rear bolt can be installed.

Make sure that all removed parts are re-installed in the same way as they were before the installation of the Öhlins shock absorber.



Note!

Lower the vehicle so that the suspension is slightly compressed before tightening the screws.


Caution!

Ensure that all screws are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.
